### **Training Venue:**

**Napier Coastguard Education Centre, 703 Meaner Quay, Napier.** This is a beautiful venue right on the waters edge, 10 minutes from airport and close to a safe swimming beach, wide range of accommodation, cafes, restaurants and a short drive to the main centre of Napier.

The **fourth module** in February, 2020 will be held on a marae in Hawkes Bay. This will be fully residential and costs are included in training fee. While bi-cultural content is included throughout the training modules this module immerses students in Kaupapa Maori experience and includes a range of additional opportunities designed to increase bi-cultural awareness and experience.

### **Training Fees:**

The training fee is \$10,000 + GST. This includes all teaching materials, required text and maraenoho costs (including accommodation and catering). A deposit of \$3000 + GST is required to secure place in the training. The remaining fees are paid in monthly installments across the rest of the training.

### **Training Application:**

Attendance at a minimum of one Hakomi workshop is a pre-requisite. It is to be noted that we do not have a closing date for applications. Students will be selected as applications are received until course is full.

Because this training is designed as a post-graduate professional training we will give priority to applicants with experience and/or training in psychotherapy, psychology, allied health professions, alternative health practitioners, body workers etc. We also consider the personal qualities of applicants in terms of their capacity to successfully achieve in this training and as such will consider those with life experiences, and other work backgrounds that support training in this work.
